FOUNDER'S PROGRESS REPORT



The mission of Bridging Freedom is to combat domestic minor sex trafficking by bringing restoration to those who are rescued and prevention to those we reach with our message.

Bridging Freedom was conceived through prayer in 2010 "to do something" for God. Prayer and passion ignited first steps, and those steps produced success.

Your partnership helped support this God-given project in the development of a safe home community for young girls rescued from child-sex trafficking.

Your generous funds provided for:

- · The development phase of the campus
- Progressive change in our State
- Awareness material and prevention tools
- Special events to educate the community about a problem targeting our vulnerable and unsuspecting children.
- Development of a safe home campus community to provide healing, hope, and purpose.

Your partnership funds have supported the goal of systemic change within the way children are holistically treated after surviving horrendous sex-slavery abuse.

Currently, most rescued children are placed back in their initial environment with few services to treat their trauma bonding and Stockholm Syndrome; therefore, victims often return to their abuser.

The successful strength-based program Bridging Freedom is replicating within our community will break her cycle of returning to the abuser by offering safety, trauma-informed therapy, health management, education, and life skills. We will help young girls recognize their potential, purpose, and dreams.

Bridging Freedom has contributed to a systemic change in how rescued girls will receive care in the State of Florida.

These key catalytic phases for success have been accomplished:

2011

### 2015/16

- Secured legislative and community grants for site development and therapeutic program funding.
- Began site development on property.
- Developed community interest for the first 2-1/2 homes to be built.

#### 2014

- Obtained land donation of nearly 100 acres.
- Continued partnering with corporations, community social clubs, churches, and individuals.
- Developed proposals for grant funding.

### 2013

- Developed processes to bring in seed funding and Freedom League Partners to grow operations.
- Developed key pro-bono partnerships.
- Educated the Governor's Cabinet and Agency Secretaries of the successful therapeutic campus model.
- Seed funding allowed full time development mid-2013

### 2012

- Developed the start-up 501c3, marketing tools, and board of directors to begin operations.
- Successful therapeutic program identified and 1-1/2 year mentorship was granted to bring the program to Florida.

 Campaigned to bring awareness and change to the issue of child sex trafficking in the State of Florida.

### 2010

 A vision was cast into the community to build a safe and healing place for rescued girls.

Support operations and development to generate progress in building a healing campus and to transition a vision into reality.



### Financial, Pro-bono & Faith Promises Recap

With so little so much has been done!



With approximately *\$460,000* in community donations, the strategic planning of Bridging Freedom, has produced:

- \$2,900,000 with \$1,200,000 recurring state grants for property site development and direct-care services
- \$500,000 value in a land donation
- \$150,000 in pro-bono project and construction management
- \$75,000 in pro-bono architectural work and reduced construction plans
- \$7,000 estimated in donated office space
- \$3,000 in office equipment
- \$15,000 in software database
- \$343,000 in Freedom League commitments
- \$861,000 in faith promises for the building of homes



### **Next Steps for Community Partnerships**

With site development underway and therapeutic program funding obtained, Bridging Freedom needs your help to finish the project.

Introductions provided by you can help us network to organizations that may potentially partner to build the remaining structures.





Each home takes approximately \$450K; each room approximately \$37K.

Two corporations have reached out to begin talks of partnerships for the intake home of 4 bed/baths and one for the six larger 8 bed/baths homes.

This would allow us to begin serving 12 young girls toward the end of 2017!

Three organizations are in talks to each build a room within the third home.

Every house has a **counseling room** for private therapy and a **dedicated education room**.

Four and a half homes, a lodge, and a chapel are still needed to serve the many children being rescued.
